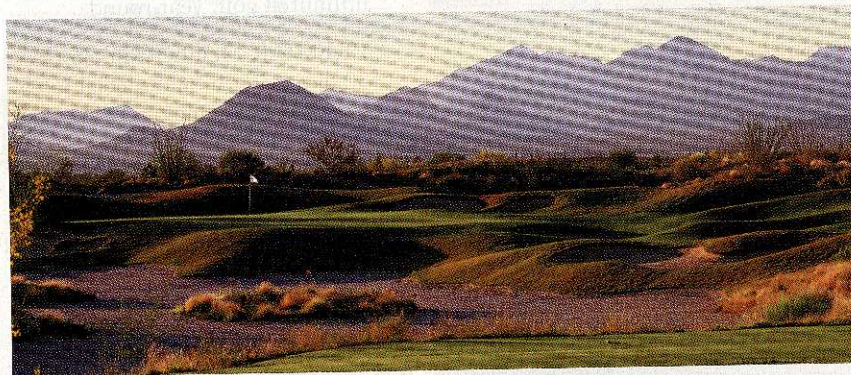

Rooting for the Chicago Cubs is an annual exercise in heartbreak, but you can ease the pain by heading from their games at HoHoKam Stadium to this playable Ken Kavanaugh desert design.

● **Trilogy Golf Club at Vistancia**

You can watch a cluster of teams clear out the winter cobwebs nearby—the Rangers, Royals, Padres and Mariners—but this Gary Panks layout with wavy native grasses and Bradshaw Mountain backdrops is the real star.

● **Omni Tucson National Golf Resort & Spa (Catalina Course)**

Golf MVPs like Arnold Palmer, Johnny Miller and Tom Watson all won PGA Tour events on the Catalina, but fans of the Diamondbacks, Rockies and World Champion White Sox should check out the new Tom Lehman-designed Sonoran course, too.

● **PGA Golf Club (South Course)**

Mets fans flocking to see Pedro pitch just down the road can sharpen their skills at the fabulous PGA Village practice grounds and then tee it up at this Tom Fazio layout, the best of the three strong tracks on site.

● **Falcon's Fire Golf Club**

Pitchers for both the Braves and the Astros train in Kissimmee, but even Roger Clemens would have a tough time mastering the mounds that define the fairways of this Rees Jones creation.
